| <p>John 1 John the Baptist denies being the Christ</p> <p>Jesus is baptised</p> <p>Jesus meets Simon Peter and his brother Andrew and spends the day with them</p> <p>Jesus meets Philip and Nathaniel</p> <p>John 2 Jesus turns water into wine at the wedding in Cana (near Galilee)</p> <p>Jesus goes to Capernaum with his mother and brothers where he stayed a few days</p> | <p>John 3 Jesus tells Nicodemus he must be 'born again' and includes:</p> <p>- John 3:14 "Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the desert, so the Son of Man must be lifted up..."</p> <p>- John 3:16 "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."</p> <p>- John 3:30 "He must become greater; I must become less."</p> <p>John 4 Jesus meets the Samaritan woman at the well</p> <p>Jesus visits Cana again</p> <p>Jesus heals the official's son</p> <p>John 5 Jesus goes to Jerusalem for a 'Feast of the Jews'</p> <p>Jesus heals the man at the Sheep Gate pool in Jerusalem</p> | <p>John 5 Jesus states that. "...the Son can do nothing by himself; he can only do what he sees the Father doing."</p> <p>- John 5:46-47 "If you believed Moses, you would believe me, for he wrote about me. But since you do not believe what he wrote, how are you going to believe what I say?"</p> <p>Chronologically John 5 ends at the same point as: - Matthew 13 - Mark 5 - Luke 8</p> | <p>John 6 (<i>Matt 14, Mark 6 & Luke 9</i>) Jesus feeds the 5,000 men and their families.</p> <p>Jesus walks on water (and Peter walks out to him)</p> <p>Jesus states, "I am the Bread of Life"</p> <p>Some of Jesus' disciples turn away</p> <p>John 7 Jesus returns to Jerusalem for the Feast of Tabernacles (early October)</p> <p>John 8 Jesus meets the woman caught in adultery</p> <p>Jesus calls Satan the 'Father of Lies'</p> <p>John 9 Jesus heals the man born blind. The disciples ask, "Who sinned, this man or his parents that he was born blind?"</p> <p>John 10 Feast of Dedication (December)</p> <p>Jesus goes to the temple</p> <p>John 11 Lazarus dies and is raised from death</p> <p>John 12 'Palm' Sunday</p> <p>Jesus talks about 'A Grain of Wheat'</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">All this happened before or during Passover</p> <p>John 13 The Last Supper</p> <p>John 14 Thomas prompts Jesus to say, "I am the Way, the Truth and the Life..."</p> <p>Jesus explains about the 'Holy Spirit'</p> <p>John 15 Jesus teaches the disciples saying, "I am the Vine, you are the branches..."</p> <p>John 16 Jesus explains again about the Holy Spirit</p> <p>John 17 Jesus prays in the garden</p> <p>John 18 Jesus arrested and Peter's denials</p> <p>John 19 Jesus sentenced and crucified</p> <p>John 20 The Resurrection</p> <p style="text-align: center;">After Passover</p> <p>John 21 The apostles go back fishing!</p> <p>Jesus reinstates Peter and has the "Do you love me?" discourse</p> |
